1. The new uniform will be phased in throughout the academic year September 2019 to September 2020

3. **Ordering uniform**

Compulsory items that are exclusive to SALTO are clearly indicated on the order form along with prices. All other items, if preferred, can be purchased from any other retail outlets.

There are several ways to order the uniform, either:

- Through the school office using the Order Form attached.
- Directly at the SALTO shop in Prudhoe.
- Online directly or via the link on the school website. (This will be available online from Monday 13th May)

NB. All orders must be prepaid

4. **Delivery**

- Uniform can be delivered to your home address at a cost of £4.50
- Click & Collect from SALTO shop in Prudhoe (SALTO inform parents via text message when an order is ready)

- Every two weeks SALTO will deliver orders directly to school. (again SALTO text parents when an order is ready to be collected from school)
- On Friday 23rd August from 9.00am – 12.00pm, St Joseph's will be open for parents from both St Joseph's and St Mary's to collect their initial uniform order if a delivery to school was requested.
